## RACE REPORT

#### **David Tavares**



**4/20: Acura Grand Prix of Long Beach:** This was a 100 minute IMSA race.

AWA Racing team out of Ontario, Canada raced the #13 Corvette Z06 GT3.R in the GTD class. This was the team and drivers Orey Fidani and Matt Bell's inaugural trip to the Long Beach circuit.

Fidani began the race in 15th position in his class. This makes me wonder why the corvette didn't place well in the qualifying laps. However, Fidani gained 3 positions in the first 12 minutes. Great job! Fidani's first pit stop was just before the 40-minute mark. The racecar changed hands and Matt Bell rejoined the race in 14th place. Despite getting hit from behind, Bell moved to the 11<sup>th</sup> spot within a couple of laps. He managed to maneuver his way to 6<sup>th</sup> place with less than 15 minutes left in the race. Bell made a valiant attempt to pass the 5<sup>th</sup> place car in the time remaining but couldn't seem to accomplish this before the end of the race. Still, team AWA made great progress from their 15<sup>th</sup> place start.

The drivers commented on how easy the Corvette was to drive and how well the racecar was glued to the corners. But they noted it lacked some straight-line speed.

Race Results: 1<sup>st</sup>: Lexus, 2<sup>nd</sup>: BMW, 3<sup>rd</sup>: Mercedes, 6<sup>th</sup>: AWA Racing Z06 GT3.R. There were 17 cars in the class.

**4/21:** 6 HOURS OF IMOLA: This was the next FIA WEC race. TF Sport raced at this iconic Italian circuit in the LMT GT3 class. This was the 2nd race of the year for their new Z06 GT3.R race car and the 1<sup>st</sup> trip to Imola for Corvette.

Charlie Eastwood, Tom Van Rompuy & Rui Andrade piloted the #81 car. Daniel Juncadella, Hiro Kouzumi & Sebastien Baud, raced the #82 car. Chaos at the start of the race gave Van Rompuy the perfect opportunity to gain 4 positions on the first two laps. Both Corvettes ascended to the top 10 positions, making them eligible for points by the two-hour mark.

Andrade & Baud were up next and had to contend with driving in the rain. Both cars managed to stay on the track, unlike some of their competitors. TF Sport was the first team to switch to wet-weather tires. However, with the track retaining most of its grip, the tire swap didn't improve their lap times much. Just before the final hour the two Corvettes changed back to dry tires, but with no advantage.

Race Results: 1<sup>st</sup>: BMW, 2<sup>nd</sup>: BMW, 3<sup>rd</sup>: Porsche, 7<sup>th</sup>: #81 Corvette Z06, 8<sup>th</sup>: #82 Corvette Z06. There were 18 cars in the class.

<u>5/9: 6 Hours of Spa-FrancorChamps:</u> This is the next race for the LMGT3 class in the WEC series. You can view the race using the FIAWEC.tv link

**5/10-12:** Laguna Seca: This will be the next IMSA race for the GTD PRO & the GTD classes. You may view this race using IMSA.com/tv/ link.

In other racing news, DXDT Racing out of Statesville, NC, unveiled two Corvette Z06 GT3.R racecars running in the Fanatec GT World Challenge America race series. They are also adding Corvette driver Tommy Milner to the lineup. DXDT has two races coming up.

<u>5/3-5. Sebring International Raceway:</u> The DXDT #08 Corvette will be racing in Florida with drivers, Scott Smithson & Bryan Sellers

<u>5/17-19. Circuit of the Americas:</u> The DXDT #63 car will be piloted by Tommy Milner & Alec Udell and will race at Circuit of the Americas in Austin, Texas




