RACE REPORT



March 2: QATAR 1812 KM.

This is the first race of the year in the WEC class for team TF Sport under the Corvette Racing banner. The #81 and #82 Corvettes raced in the LMGT3 class. This is the first-time drivers Daniel Juncadella, Sebastien Baud, and Hiroshi Koizumi, worked together as they drove the #82 Corvette.

Koizumi started the race in the 11th spot. He drove for 90 minutes in heavy traffic and handed the car off to Baud. Baud, the youngest of the drivers, at 23 years old, kept pace with his more experienced teammates. Juncadella took over and drove 3-1/2 hours, ending his stint in 10th place. Despite the team's best efforts and some penalties, the #82 racecar finished in 10th place.

Meanwhile, the #81 Corvette was piloted by Tom Van Rompuy, Rui Andrade and Charlie Eastwood. Van Rompuy ran in pole position for the first 20 minutes. Rui Andrade then had his stint behind the wheel and remained in the top 10 just before the 2-1/2 hour mark, when he spun out, which caused him to lose time to the cars he was chasing.

Then the team had to change the electronic shifter which caused a 7 lap loss. After returning to the track with Eastwood driving, the team discovered an electrical issue with a wiring harness. This ended the race for the #81 car. The drivers commented about the valuable data they collected on this first race. The TF Sport team and Chevrolet will work together to find the issues with the racecar before the next race.

March 13-16: 12 Hours of Sebring

This will be the next race in the IMSA race series at Sebring International Raceway in Sebring, Florida. Pratt Miller and AWA Racing teams will be running in the GTD Pro and GTD class.

April 21: 6 HOURS OF IMOLA

TF Sport will travel to this Italian circuit to start testing for their next race.

In other racing news, IMSA issued points penalties to Ferrari and BMW in the GTD Pro and GTD classes for Manufacturer's Points and Michelin Endurance Challenge Points. These penalties were for violating the new Balance Of Performance System.

What does this mean? The Balance of Performance system is the method the racing sanctioning body uses to keep the performance level of the cars as even as possible in order to maintain a fair advantage amongst the race teams.

Before the start of the season, each team conducted practice sessions and data from the practice sessions were sent to the IMSA officials. They determine what changes, if any, are required to the race car to balance their performance with the rest of the race cars in the class.

According to IMSA, both teams demonstrated performance in the Daytona 24 hour race that exceeded IMSA's expectations. Basically, they were accused of "sandbagging". Both manufacturers will be fined \$25K on top of losing their points. Due to these teams point loss, Porshe moved into the lead with Manufacturer's points and Corvette moved into the lead with Michelin Endurance Cup points.
