

RACE REPORT

The Corvette race team had not raced since our last month's meeting. So, this month I'll bring up a few interesting stories concerning racing.

The first bit of news concerns the new Z06 GT3.R that Chevrolet will be selling to other race teams in 2024. Chevrolet is setting up a factory driver pool to help race teams with driving the new Z06 GT3.R. This brings up questions about Corvette Racing competing in the same races as the other race teams. Chevrolet is still working on how all this will play out. In other interesting news, Car and Driver magazine conducts a test called "Lightning Lap" at Virginia International Raceway (VIR) to find the fastest lap times for the latest track stars. This testing started about 17 years ago.

This year they tested a Rapid Blue 2023 Z07 that ran an astonishing 2:38.6. What does this mean?

- o The C8 Z07 is the 5th fastest car that's **ever** been in the test.
- o It is the fastest American car to ever run in this test.
- o It is the fastest naturally aspirated car to **ever** run in the test.
- o It is the fastest < \$200K car to ever run in the test.

The C8 Z07 officially passed the track record of the Corvette beast known as the C7 ZR1 ZTK. The other American car to run well in this test, was the Ford GT. To purchase a Ford GT, a person had to apply, just to be considered as an owner. Yet, this car holds the 13th spot in track time.

The last bit of news I have concerns Jim France, who is the chairman/CEO of NASCAR and the chairman of IMSA racing. France had the idea to see how a stock NASCAR can hold up in the 24 hour Le Mans. He decided to set up a race team called Garage 56 Le Mans. France is using Hendrick Motorsports to enter a slightly modified NASCAR Camaro ZL1 in the 24 Hour Le Mans as an exhibition car. It's nice to hear that the throaty cross plane crankshaft style of Corvette engine in the Camaro will be represented in the 24 Hour of Le Mans. Corvette race driver Jordan Taylor will be serving as coach for the Garage 56 Le Mans team. The Le Mans race will be on June 10th and 11th.

Corvette's next race for IMSA is the 12 hours of Sebring on Saturday, March 18 for the GTE PRO class.

The WEC season begins on Friday, March 17th, at the 1000 miles of Sebring, with the #64 Vette.
