# RACE REPORT David Tavares



#### IMSA, Chevrolet Grand Prix, Canadian Tire Motorsport Park, Bowmanville ON, July 9 For the IMSA series, the No. 3 race Corvette raced at Bowmanville, Ontario, Canada on July 9<sup>th</sup>. This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> time the C8R raced at this park. Antonio Garcia and Jordan Taylor were ready for their challenge.

Taylor started out in 4<sup>th</sup> place. At 33 minutes into the race, Taylor pitted early. He swapped with Garcia as the Corvette Racing crew changed tires and added fuel. When the Corvette left the pit lane, they were in 3rd place overall and second among the cars in their class that stopped early.

An even more critical moment came with 70 minutes remaining. Garcia moved to the lead on a restart as the two cars ahead of him ran off the track while fighting off each other. The Corvette held the proper line and moved by each. The top three cars ran less than 4 seconds apart for the final 24 minutes with the Corvette taking the win under a yellow flag. The **No. 3 Corvette C8.R claimed the season's first GTD PRO victory**!

#### IMSA, FCP Euro Northeast Grand Prix, Lime Rock Park, Lakeville CT, July 22

Corvette Racing's next race was the FCP Euro Northeast Grand Prix on Saturday, July 22nd from Lime Rock Park in Lakeville, Connecticut. Garcia maintained his 3<sup>rd</sup> place position for the first 90 minutes of the race. The Vette made a pit stop for fuel and left side tires, while the Aston Martin stayed on the track. After the pitstop, Corvette had great difficulty trying to get around the Aston Martin. This meant they needed to try to save fuel and avoid unneeded pit stops to gain track position.

Garcia brought the Vette back into the pit for the last time with 72 minutes left and from 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Taylor took over and stalled as he tried to leave the pitbox. He lost 10 seconds because the car wouldn't go back into gear. This mishap resulted in *Taylor ending the race with a 4<sup>th</sup> place finish*.

#### IMSA SportsCar Weekend, Road America, Elkhart Lake, WI, August 4-6

Corvettes next race was the IMSA SportsCar Weekend at Road America on August 4-6<sup>th</sup> in Elkhart Lake, Wisconsin. Taylor got things started early by getting the jump at the drop of the green flag with a run from 3rd to 2nd place by the first corner. He moved into the class lead just before the 40-minute mark. Taylor handed off to Garcia at the 51-minute mark. Having been the last of the top three cars to pit, Garcia and the No. 3 Corvette carried a fuel advantage for the race's second and final scheduled pit stop.

Garcia emerged directly ahead of the Aston Martin and barely in the lead.

Things changed, however, as the No. 3 team was forced to serve a penalty for not meeting the minimum refueling time required by sanctioning body IMSA on the final stop. Team and series officials discussed the matter. But the call stood and Garcia had to give up the lead with 24 minutes left. *The Corvette finished third in the GTD PRO class at Road America.* 

#### IMSA, Michelin GT Challenge, Virginia International Raceway, August 25-27

Corvette Racing's next event for IMSA is the Michelin GT Challenge at VIR on August 25-27 from Virginia International Raceway in Alton, Virginia.

For the WEC side of Corvette racing, the team competed in the Six Hours of Monza in MONZA, Italy on July 9<sup>th</sup>. The team consisted of Nicky Catsburg, Ben Keating and Nico Varrone. Keating set the tone for the Corvette team early. He started in 6th place and moved his way up to 3<sup>rd</sup> prior to a safety-car period at the 15-minute mark. The Corvette crew brought the race car into the pitlane for a fuel top-off. By the time Keating made his 2<sup>nd</sup> stop at 80 minutes running, he had worked his way to 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Keating handed the car off to Varrone just past the two-hour mark. But a rare in-race mistake meant the C8.R was called in for a drive-through penalty due to speeding in the pitlane. Varrone slid back to 6<sup>th</sup>. But he steadily worked his way back to the lead with strong pace and the pit stop cycle. By the time his driving time was complete just before the 4-hour mark, the C8.R ran 3rd and less than four seconds from the leader.

Catsburg drove the final 92 minutes but was unable to make any headway. All of the leaders were from the same manufacturer and ran more than 100 pounds lighter than the Corvette. This was due to GTE AM sporting rules dictating the addition of "success ballast" due to all of the Corvette's previous successes.

The **Corvette ended with a 4**<sup>th</sup> **place finish**. The No. 33 Corvette C8.R team finished ahead of its closest championship competitors to wrap up the program's first title in the World Endurance Championship competition.

It's been a dream season for Corvette Racing with three 1<sup>st</sup> place finishes, in addition to a runner-up finish at the Six Hours of Spa.

There were 12 cars total in the LM GTE AM class.

The next race for Corvette in the WEC series is the Six Hours of Fuji on September 10<sup>th</sup>.






